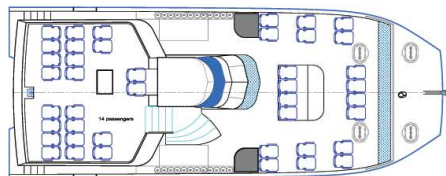
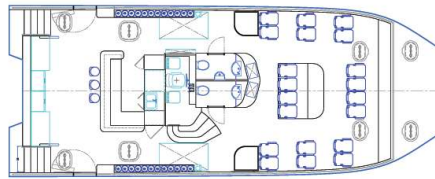

The Hula Kai is a 53.4' x 21' Teknicraft catamaran owned by Kona Sunrise Charters, LLC, located on The Big Island of Hawaii. The 49 passenger vessel will be used for snorkel tours and excursions that offer customers first-class ecological adventures.

The vessel was designed to meet the owner's specific requirements and provide versatility for the many different functions of the vessel. The Hula Kai is used for dive trips, snorkel tours, whale watching cruises, and exclusive charters.

The speed, comfort, and excellent seakeeping ability of the Teknicraft hull make it possible to travel to remote locations during the daily 5 hour cruise.

The Hula Kai is powered by two Cummins QSC8.3M490 engines, each delivering 490 horsepower at 2600 rpm and drawing from two 200 gallon diesel fuel tanks. The propulsion package includes two 5 blade Osborne propellers, coupled to ZF 305A transmissions.
